Talent Show

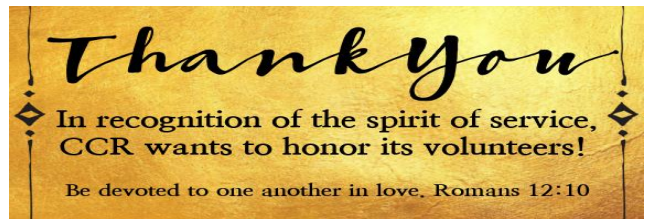
Evening of February 26th

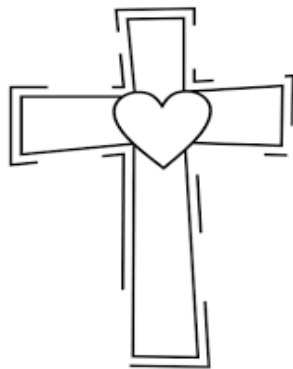
