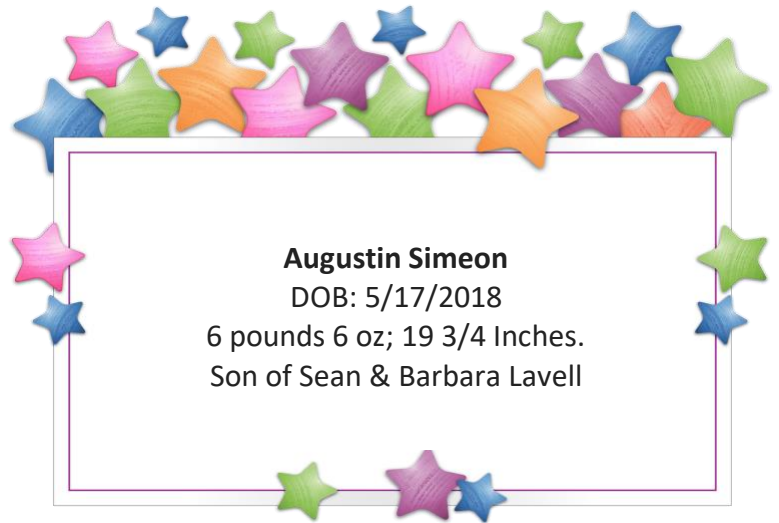

Summer Safety Reminder

Parents please read over these safety guidelines communicate expectations with your children.
